

Call for Nominations for Editors of Digital Communications and Networks (DCN)

Overview

The IEEE Communication Society (ComSoc) Technical Committee on Green Communications and Computing (TCGCC) invites nominations for *two Editors* for the journal Digital Communications and Networks (DCN). DCN publishes quarterly in partnership with ScienceDirect (Elsevier), KeAi Publishing (Science Press) and Chongqing University of Post and Telecommunications, China. DCN is an open access journal in the field of Communications, Networks, Computing, Services and Applications without any publication fee. The journal is indexed by Science Citation Index Expanded (SCIE) and Scopus. DCN has impact factor **5.382** and ranked in **JCR Q1**. DCN is also ranked **4th** in the field of “Telecommunications” in Web of Science.

The Scope of DCN

Digital Communications and Networks (DCN) publishes rigorously peer-reviewed, high quality original papers and authoritative reviews that focus on communication systems and networks. All papers are published fully Open Access in ScienceDirect. One of the objectives of the journal is to be the prime reference on the communication systems, networks, services and applications.

Topics of interest include but are not limited to: AI-Driven Communications and Networks; Big Data Networking and Applications; Blockchain and Distributed Ledger Technologies; Cellular Communications and Networks; Coding and Information Theory; Communications and Networking Standards; Consumer Communications and Networking; Cyber-Physical Systems; Edge, Fog, and Cloud Computing and Networks; Future Internet Architecture, Protocols, and Applications; Green Communications; Industrial Internet and Industry 4.0; Internet of Things; Intelligent Communications and Networking Systems; Network, Service, and Applications Management; Optical Communications and Networking; Pervasive Computing and Networking; Quantum Computing, Communications, and Information; Satellite Communications and Networking in Space; Trust, Security, and Privacy Protocols; Unified Communications, Computing, and Control; Vehicular Communications and Networks; Wireless Communications and Networking; Wireless Sensor Networks

Nominee

The nominee must be a member in good standing of the IEEE ComSoc TCGCC, with a background in the field of Communications Systems, Networking, Computing, and Services. Desirable qualities include: solid technical accomplishments, integrity and ethical standards. The duties include interaction with authors, initiating and monitoring the review process to its completion, ensuring that the journal follows the journal Policy and Procedures, maintaining the intellectual integrity and timeliness of the journal. The standard term of an editor is 2 years and can be renewed for another 2 years.

Nominations must include:

- Name of candidate and nominator (self-nominations are acceptable).

- A brief biography of the nominee of no more than one page with: (i) relevant research activities that are directly aligned with the scope of the journal; and (ii) the contributions/involvement in TCGCC
- The candidate's 2-page CV with relevant publication lists, editorial and review, and a list of up to 6-8 keywords that the candidate can handle for DCN
- The elements of the nomination package should be combined as a single PDF file with the nominee's CV appended at the end

Nomination submission

Deadline: August 30, 2020

Selection

We will conduct a voting process in the selection committee and then select up to two (2) candidates per the above requirements. TCGCC will send the selected candidates to the EIC of DCN and EIC will make the final decision.
